To see if the Bethlehem Elementary School District will vote to raise and appropriate the amount of \$3,810,074 for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for the school district officials and agents, and for the payment for the statutory obligations of the district. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. (Majority vote required)

#### Article 04: Deficit Warrant

To see if the school district will vote to raise \$239,969 to reduce the general fund deficit pursuant to RSA 194:3-b. (Majority vote required)

To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
