

## Principal's Report

\*Tammy Sanborn, guidance counselor, will be attending the meeting to talk about her role at BES.

\* I would like the Board to accept bids for the painting of the window trim as well as repairing/shoring up the exterior sills.

\*I know the subject of sub pay came up and we tabled the idea of raising our rate until the 2023-2024 school year. The administrators have discussed the more immediate need, and once we are all on the same page, I will present it to the Board.

\*Since our support staff is not unionized, I am presenting the Board with a request that came to me. I was asked if we could create a sick bank for support staff to use. I made it clear it would be closely monitored by me. I was also asked if they could increase the number of days they can accumulate. Currently they can accumulate 30 days.

\*Our budget committee has been meeting the past few Fridays. The committee is made up of James, Dawn Aldrich and Toni from the SAU, Lisa Brown, Brooke Campbell, Allison Culver and me. It has been very productive, and we have had some important conversations.

\*The school will be hosting a vaccination/booster shot clinic on Wednesday the 9<sup>th</sup>. Staff and students can get their flu shot and/or their Covid booster shot.
